Medieval Porto and Douro River

The purpose of the visit is to understand the evolution of Porto, following the town planning and the union of two nucleous (the religious acropolis and the civic and commercial bank of the river), observing the outline of the missing Gothic wall and following some arteries of elite and of specific trades. On the other hand, we will take the opportunity to understand the impact of the establishment in medieval town of the main ecclesiastical orders: the Franciscans and the Dominicans. The boat trip will allow us to grasp the city's different phases of expansion.

Medieval Braga and Guimarães

The visit to the historical centres of the cities of Guimarães and Braga aims essentially to understand the historical and artistic organization of the main structures of these cities and its crucial role in the military and religious history of the Portuguese Middle Ages. During this period, Braga was the most important religious center. Regarding Guimarães, in the course of the pedestrian circuit between the Castle and the Collegiate, explanation will be provided on the urban relevance of the street of Santa Maria as a structural element of the city development.

Medieval and Baroque Coimbra

In this visit two approaches are at work to present Coimbra. The first make know the city through a visit to historical places as the University, the Old Cathedral and the Monastery of Santa Cruz. The second aims to give knowledge of the most modern diffusion and patrimonial conservation strategies and infrastructures, through the visits to the National Museum Machado de Castro and the Monastery of Santa Clara-a-Velha (Museum). In a chronological extension of many centuries, we will visit the *Alta* (uptown) and *Baixa* (downtown) areas of the city and the left bank of the river Mondego.
